Vista, 11, 2002, in the Hacienda Rehabilitation and Care Center at Sierra Vista.

granddaughters, four brothers, Edward, Willie, Joe and Steve; four sisters, Sophie, Marie, Cora and

Gertrude Heleena (Hasky) Mekosky, 95, died Dec. 17, 2013, at Hacienda Rehabilitation and Care Center in Sierra Vista, Ariz. She had been a resident of Sierra Vista, Ariz., since 1988.

She grew up on a farm on Wishkah Road and, along with husband Sigmund, managed the dairy and beef farm. They sold the farm in 1965, and moved to Aberdeen.

She was a volunteer in the Air Force Ground Observer Corp having served over 3,000 hours before the service was decommissioned in 1958.
