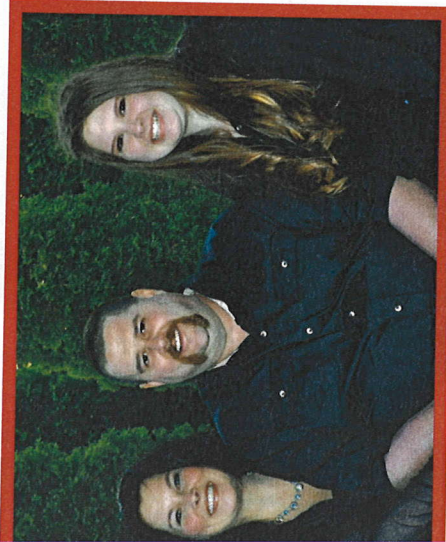


BROTHER, SON, FATHER, HUSBAND, FRIEND

Each summer Chad made his way to Westport to spend time with his sisters Ferrell and Cindy, and would also work the charter boats. Eventually relocating to Westport, Chad graduated from Ocoosa High School in 1988.



In 1995, Chad met the love of his life Danielle Busz. They were married Dec. 14, 1996, at the Grand Heron Ballroom in Aberdeen. On August 4, 1999, they welcomed their daughter, Kaydee Elizabeth into the world and later made their home in Montesano.

Chad's journey in the fire service began in 1990 while volunteering for the Ocoosa Fire Department at the Westport Fire Department and South Beach Ambulance Service. Before receiving his Paramedic certification in 1998 he was certified as an EMT and one of the first paid members of South Beach Ambulance.

In August of 1999, Chad was hired by the Aberdeen Fire Department as a Fire Paramedic. He was promoted to Fire Engineer/Paramedic in July 2009, a rank he served in until his passing. Chad was an integral part of the day-to-day operations of the Aberdeen Fire Department and local fire service. Within the department served as a member of the SCBA, Water Supply and Apparatus Selection Committee as well as serving as an instructor and member of the Investigations Team for over 20 years.

Chad loved to mentor youth through coaching many sports, including basketball, softball. Teaching not just the game, but important life skills. Through his Mitts Tractor Works he was able to donate time and equipment to improve athletic fields in the community. Chad also loved fishing, bowling, farming, and spending time with family and friends.

Chad's brother, son, father, husband and friend will be dearly missed. His contribution to the safety and health of our community will NEVER BE FORGOTTEN.
