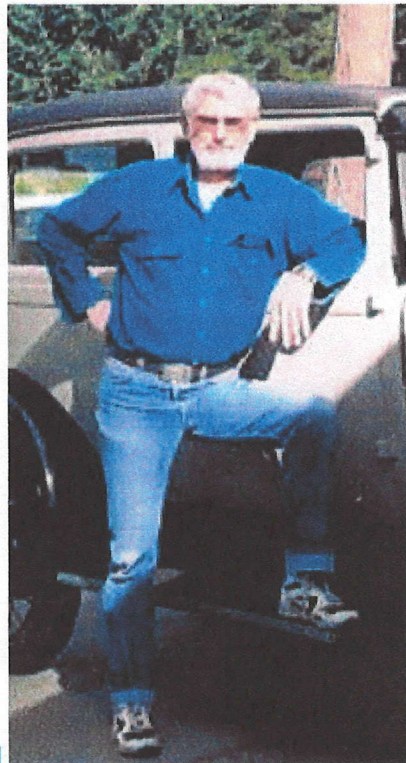
**James E. Akers (Ed)**
