John Koziol, a logger and shake cutter who was a lifelong Grays Harbor resident, died Tuesday in a local nursing home. He was 71.

Koziol was born June 22, 1915, in the Wishkah Valley. He served in the Army during World War II.

A member of IWA 3-2 in Aberdeen, Kaziol was a logger and a shake cutter prior to his retirement in 1968.

He is survived by a brother, Tom Koziol of Hoquiam; three sisters, Mary Hargrove and Veronica Helm, both of Aberdeen and Mrs. Gilbert (Julia) Parker of Mason Lake, Wash.

A graveside service will be at 1 p.m. Monday at St. John's Cemetery in the Wishkah Valley. Arrangements are by the Fern Hill Funeral Home. Nov 24
