Charles E. White, 85, who resided at 701 Old Hill Rd., died yesterday at a local hospital. He was born Nov. 4, 1886 at West Union, Iowa and farmed in Iowa before coming to Washington in 1935. He worked in plywood factories and was a custodian at Central Park school for the past several years. He served as a special deputy for the Grays Harbor Sheriff Office (in that capacity he was in a movie as an extra, playing himself, called "The Ring of Fire") He belonged to St. Mary's Church in Aberdeen. Surviving are three daughters, Mrs. Peter (Esther) Bakotich of Aberdeen, Mrs. Warren (Clara) Busz of the Wishkah Valley, Mrs. Kenneth (Bernadine) Mitchell of Hoquiam, nine sons, Paul and Leo of Hoquiam, August of Wishkah, Carl of Central, Frank of Cresco, Iowa, Ernest of Ocosta, Vincent and Anthony of Aberdeen and Robert of Amanda Park, 54 grandchildren 81 great grandchildren and 2 great-great grandchildren.
