EARL ALVIN BARNES

Earl Alvin Barnes, 93, a long time Wishkah Valley resident. Died Tuesday at Grays Harbor Community Hospital. (*Oct. 7, 1989)

He was born Oct. 4, 1896 at Farmington, Wash.

He married Leona May Arth in 1922 in Idaho. The couple moved to Wishkah Valley area in 1941, where they had a farm. Barnes worked in sawmills for several years prior to working at Bell's Feed Store and then for Linnenkohl's until his retirement in 1964.

Mrs. Barnes died in 1981. His survivors include two daughters, Bernell Eby and Beatrice E. Brown, both of Aberdeen., a half brother, Edward Barnes of California; six grandchildren and 11 great grandchildren.

A graveside service is set for 11 a/m/ Friday at St. John's Cemetery at Wishkah. Direction is by the Coleman Mortuary of Hoquiam.
