He worked for Rayonier Pulp Mill from 1938 to 1941 after which time he worked on his father's dairy farm. He later had his own dairy farm and together with his wife operated the farm until 1967. In addition to working for Lawrence and Macan Fuel from 1946 to 1980, he also ran a milk route from 1957 to 1960; picking up the farmer's milk which needed to be delivered to 2 local dairies. He had 2 sons, William of Gaston, Oregon and John of Olympia. He also had 4 grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren. He also has 2 brothers, Jerry of Aberdeen and Adolph of Olympia.
