George E. Bennett

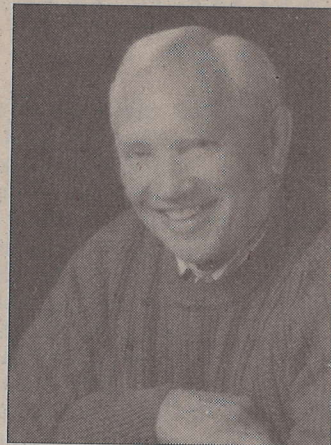
