

Upon talking to Mr. Hyde of Coleman's re Barbara/Don Blakely headstone removal/replacement.

He suggested first that Mr. Blakely be conferred with directly. That this is his wish; for the headstone to be replaced with a single headstone and that he no longer wishes to be buried at St. John's. Secondly inform Mr. Blakely that the cemetery will need a letter to that effect, witnessed by two people it is his desire to remove/replace the double headstone with a single headstone and that the single headstone will be put in place by the monument company removing the double headstone. When the single headstone (for Barbara Blakely) is on site, and a letter signed by him and witnessed by two people stating it is his wish to not be buried at St. John's. A refund will be given him for the cost of his portion of the double plot upon presentation of a receipt as to the cost of the double plot.
