



#### CLARA MAE (WHITE) BUSZ

As Clara approached the "sunset " years of her life, her mental capabilities were not as they once were. She was often reminiscing in the past. Frequently telling stories of times long ago. Always well known for relating her life as a girl growing up in such a large family of mostly boys on farms in Iowa, all the chores that were required of her; from milking cows, to feeding, turkeys, geese and chickens, gathering eggs, cooking huge dinners to feed "thrashing " crews, to taking care of all her smaller siblings.

Clara moved to Karr House, an assisted living home in Woodlawn (a community between Wishkah Valley and Hoquiam). She had a small apartment there and seemed to be quite content. She was close enough for family members to visit her often. Clara celebrated her 91st birthday at Karr House, she was in reasonably good health and perked up when her family came around her.

Clara fell at Karr house, fracturing her pelvis, she went to Community hospital and then was transferred to Pacific Care Nursing Home on Cherry St. in Hoquiam, where she remains today. She went to Pacific Care April 11, 1999, where she remained until she passed away on May 8, 2000. She would have celebrated her 92nd birthday August 28th.

Clara passed away at 6:00 P.M. on May 8, 2000 while at Pacific Care facility. She was cremated, and because some of her children were gone on vacation, services were postponed until July 15th. A private family gathering with Father Dan Conroy officiating was held at St. John's Cemetery in the Wishkah Valley, where she was laid to rest beside her husband of 55 years, Warren Busz.
