Charles E. White, 85, who resided at 701 Old Hill Rd., died yesterday at a local hospital. He was born Nov. 4, 1886 at West Union, Iowa and farmed in Iowa before coming to Washington in 1935. He worked in plywood factories and was a custodian at Central Park school for the past several years. He served as a special deputy for the Grays Harbor Sheriff Office (in that capacity he was in a movie as an extra, playing himself, called "The Ring of Fire") He belonged to St. Mary's Church in Aberdeen.
