Warren L. Busz, 76, a longtime Wishkah Valley resident, died Monday at his home. He was born May 5, 1911, at Albion, Ind. and moved to Grays Harbor in 1918. He had worked for the Schafer Bros. Logging Co. and he worked at the Weyerhaeuser Sawmill for 18 years. Before his retirement in 1973, he worked for six years in the Weyerhaeuser chip department. He married Clara White in 1933 in Tacoma. She survives at the family home. Busz was a volunteer for the Wishkah Fire Department for several years. He loved hunting, fishing and gardening.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by two sons, David Busz of Wishkah Valley and Daniel Busz of Gig Harbor; a stepson, Clarence Aschim of Aberdeen; two daughters, Mrs. Loren (Loretta) Conway of Aberdeen and Mrs. Ed (Darlene) Akers of Olalla, Wash.; a sister, Mrs. Oscar (Nellie) Edwards of Brady; 19 grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

Warren worked in the woods as a logger for most of his life, retired from Weyerhaeuser, he was first man to run the chip pile operation for Weyco. The Busz family originally lived on the "Home Place" then rented Henry Gregor's little house across the road from the "Home Place", then moved to Lower Wishkah and rented house from Teresea Dianovich, this house burned down. Warren/ Clara bought house next to the Wishkah fire station from Sam/ Hannalore "Hannah" (?) Hayes ( See Kay Busz genealogy for more information)
