TYRUS "TY" COBB

Tyrus "Ty" Cobb, 32, a petty officer 2nd class with the U.S. Navy who grew up in Hoquiam, died at Baker Lake near Bremerton, Sunday, May 3, 1992. He was born July 31, 1959, in Coulderport, Pa., to Duncan and Marilyn (Barker) Cobb. The family moved to Hoquiam, where he attended school, graduating from Hoquiam High School in 1978. He played on the football and wrestling teams.

He joined the Navy in 1981 and at different times was in stationed in the Philpines for 18 months and in the Antartica for six months in support of the National Science Foundation. He was last stationed in Mugu, Calif.

He was an avid fisherman, hunter, and enjoyed camping, gardening and all sports.

In 1981, he married Terry Boober at Aberdeen. She survives at Aberdeen. Other survivors include a daughter, Mtra of Aberdeen, his mother at Hoquiam' three brothers, Duncan Jr. of Montesano, David of Portland and Clark of Hoquiam; three sisters, Dotti Smith of Astoria, Ore, Mrs. John (Debbi) Matisons and Mrs. Bill (Karen) Linne, both of Hoquiam. His father died in 1988. A graveside service is set for 10 a.m. at St. John's Cemetery in the Wishkah Valley. A memorial service will follow at 1 p.m. at the Aberdeen Church of the Open Bible.
