

Tyrus "Ty" Cobb

BAKER LAKE, Wash. — Tyrus "Ty" Cobb, 32, a petty officer 2nd class with the U.S. Navy who grew up in Hoquiam, died at Baker Lake near Bremerton Sunday, May 3, 1992.

He was born July 31, 1959, in Coudersport, Pa., to Duncan and Marilyn (Barker) Cobb. The family moved to Hoquiam, where he attended school, graduating from Hoquiam High School in 1978. He played on the football and wrestling teams.

He joined the Navy in 1981 and at different times was stationed in the Phillipines for 18 months and in the Antarctica for six months in support of the National Science Foundation. He was last stationed near Point Mugu, Calif.

He was an avid fisherman, hunter, and enjoyed camping, gardening and all sports.

In 1981, he married Terry Boober at Aberdeen. She survives at Aberdeen.
