SEATTLE - Frederick William Lowe, 87, a resident of Wishkah for the past 21 years, died on Tuesday, Nov. 18, 1997, at a Seattle hospital as a result of a traffic accident. He was born on March 20, 1910, at Arlington, to Robert N. and Faith I. (Miller) Lowe. He graduated from high school at Auburn Academy and attended Walla Walla Community College where he received his teaching degree. He married Marie M. Helberg on June 20, 1936 in Aberdeen. She died in 1994. Lowe served as principal at Olympia Junior Academy, Monroe Junior Academy, Tacoma Junior Academy, Chehalis Junior Academy and was a teacher at the Auburn Academy before he retired in the mid 1970's. Mr. Lowe and his wife moved to Wishkah in 1976. Recently, he enjoyed gardening and Ornithology. He also belonged to the Seventh-day Adventist Church. Survivors include a daughter, Marian Dawes of College Place; two sisters, Velma Pinckney of Anacortes and Norma Carter of Bellingham; four grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. **Aberdeen Man killed in head-on crash**

Fife- Aberdeen resident Frederick William Lowe, 87, was killed Tuesday when the car he was driving collided head-on with another car on Interstate 5 near Fife, the Stat Patrol said. Southbound traffic was backed up several miles for more than two hours after the accident, which occurred at 9:19 a.m. just north of the Fife exit. Lowe was northbound when his 1989 Mitsubshi Galant crossed the grassy meridian and crashed into a Ford Escort driven by a Seattle resident Arthur L. Richardson, 29. Lowe's was the rammed from behind by another car, troopers said. Richardson escaped with relatively minor injuries and was reported in satisfactory condition at Harborview Medical Center in Seattle. The driver of the third car, 53 year old Charles Lander from the Bellevue area, was treated as an out-patient at St. Francis Hospital in Federal Way. Lowe who lived at 5149 Wishkah Road, was wearing a seatbelt, but was pronounced dead at Harborview. Investigators could not immediately explain what caused Lowe's car to cross into oncoming lanes.
