Marie M. Lowe, 83, a longtime Wishkah Valley resident, died Tuesday Jan. 25, 1994, at her home, following an extended illness.

She was born on Dec. 13, 1910, in Center, Colo., to Robert and Ana (Meyers) Helberg.

She was raised and attended schools in Oklahoma. The family moved to Grays Harbor in 1923. They built a home in the Wishkah area in 1924. She attended the Wishkah Valley School and Aberdeen High School.

Mrs. Lowe attended the University of Washington for two years, where her studies focused on mathematics education. She then attended Washington State Normal School at Ellensburg.

According to her family, she was among the last group of teachers to be issued a life teaching certificate.

She returned to the Wishkah area where she taught for two years at the Wishkah Valley School. In 1933 she moved to Darrington and taught first and second grades.

She was married to F. William Lowe in 1937 at her parents' home in the Upper Wishkah Valley.

The couple later returned to the Wishkah Valley so Mrs. Lowe could care for her mother. The Lowes later moved to Shelton.

Mrs. Lowe was a member of the Washington Conference of Seventh-day Adventist Church and the Grays Harbor Seventh-day Adventist Church at Hoquiam.

She taught school in Olympia from 1943 until 1947, and was an education instructor for first through sixth grades in Tacoma, Monroe, Chehalis and at the Auburn Academy. She retired in 1976.

She enjoyed working with young people and spending time outdoors. At church youth summer camps, she taught biology and nature subjects. She also enjoyed working in her yard and vegetable garden.

In addition to her husband at the family home, survivors include a daughter, Marian
