Harvey H. Lynch, 71, a longtime Aberdeen resident, died this morning at his home. He was born April 17, 1914, at Menomoni, Mich., and came to Grays Harbor in 1953 from Clintonville, Wis. He had a ranch on the upper Wishkah Valley for 12 years. He moved to his Aberdeen home in 1977. His wife, Beatrice, died in 1979. He had been a driver for the O.N.C. Trucking Co. from 1954 until his retirement in 1978. He was a member of the Teamsters Union. He is survived by a son, Wayne Lynch of Layton, Utah; a daughter, Mrs. Walter (Janet) Mussehl of Kingsford, Mich.; a stepson, Ronald Wiseman, of Olympia; a stepdaughter Dawn Graham of Hoquiam; two brother, Eugene Lynch of Aberdeen and Edward Lynch of Kiel, Wis.; nine grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.
